Description	Definition	Connection to terrorism
Activism Activist	The use of direct, often confrontational action in support of, or opposition to, a cause.	
Advocacy Advocate	Arguing in favour of something.	
Agitation Agitator Agitate	To arouse interest in something using words.	
Combat Combatant	To take part in fighting.	
Demonstration Demonstrator Demonstrate	A public display of opinion.	
Extremism Extremist	Views and opinions that extend beyond the norm.	
Fanaticism Fanatic Fanatical	Excessive enthusiasm, especially for a cause.	
Freedom fighter	Engaged in resistance against oppressors.	
Guerrilla	Irregular group of armed civilians using military tactics.	
Insurgent Insurrection	Rebelling against the authorities.	
Militant Militancy	Aggression, fighting.	
Opponent Opposition Oppose	Against another person or group.	
Pressure group	An organisation that tries to change the law according to its interests.	
Protestor Protest	Taking part in a public display of opinion	
Radical Radicalise Radicalisation	Fundamental, often extreme changes.	
Revolutionary Revolt Revolution	Making basic changes to society.
