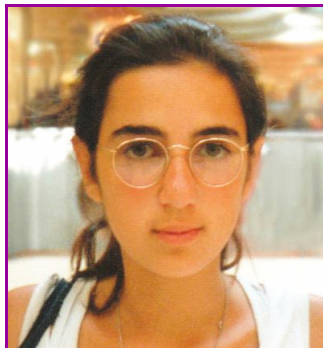


Miriam Hyman Memorial Trust

- 7/7/05 is the day that four terrorists randomly killed fifty-two people on London transport, injured several hundred, and left countless others in severe shock. There were three bomb attacks on London Underground and one on a bus.
- The suicide bombers who carried out the attacks were all born and brought up in the UK. Their families originally came from other countries.
- One of the people killed on 7/7 was Miriam Hyman who was on her way to work on a bus when it was blown up in Tavistock Square in central London.
- Her family and friends tried to deal with this dreadful event by doing something to benefit others.
- They set up the **Miriam Hyman Memorial Trust** to help build a society where we could all live in greater harmony and peace, no matter what our background, religion, or traditions.

Miriam's Vision

- Miriam's Vision is brought to you through a series of unique lessons in school. They are about -
 - Getting through difficult situations by thinking and understanding rather than reacting emotionally.
 - Understanding and respecting people with different backgrounds instead of fearing them.
 - Making a difference to other people by doing things to benefit them.
